

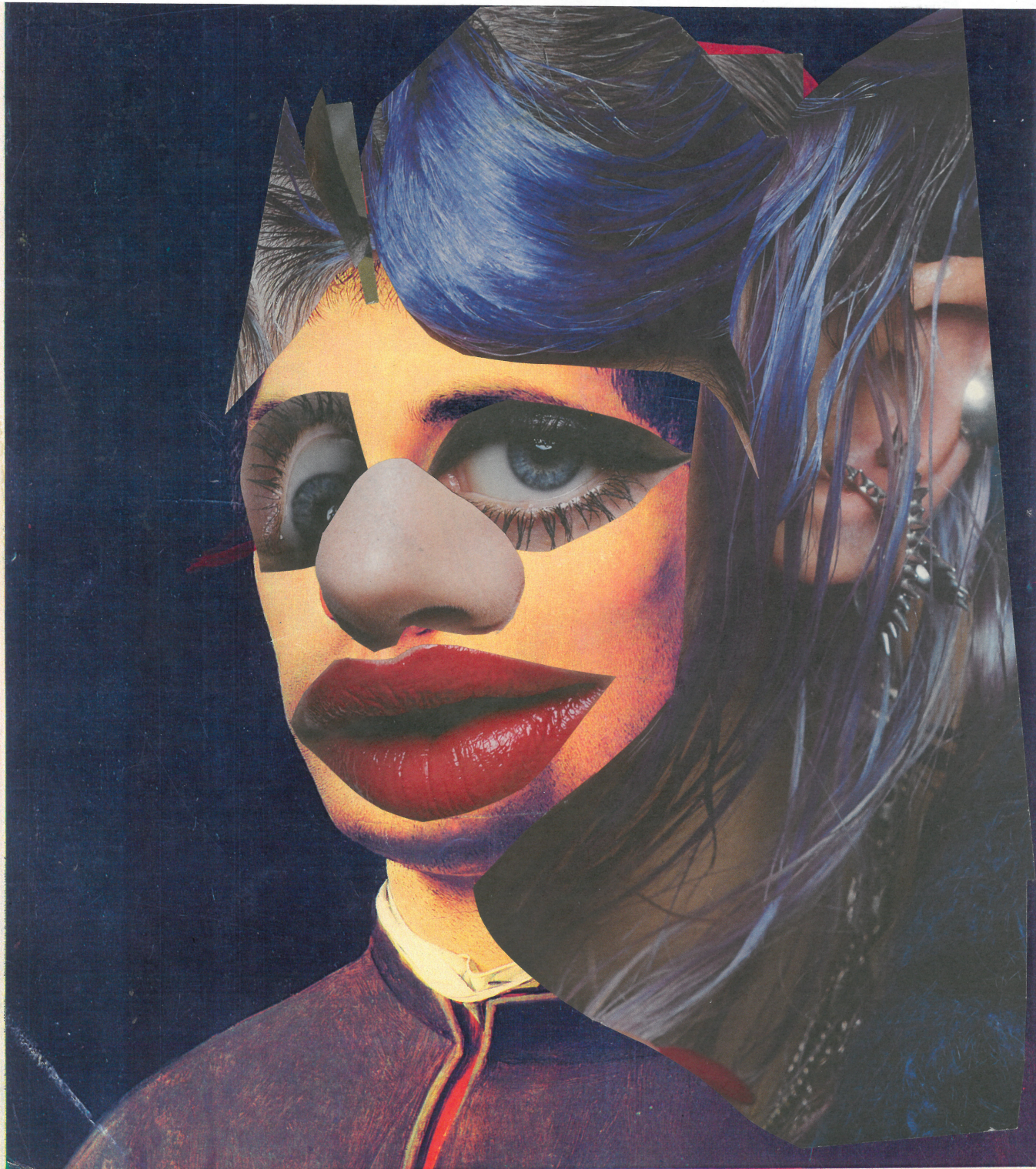

## 5: point plan

• 1 you'll need : back board, card, MDF  
big photo of a head  
other photos, scissors,  
glue: gum, Pritt

• 2 sources : posters, magazines,  
calendars, newspaper pics.  
Study the Art of Hannah Hoch, Georg Grosz

• 3 to begin : stick the big photo to the  
board. Cut eyes, mouth,  
nose, ears, hair from other  
pics. Stick on top

• 4 stuck? : cut new features to  
cover. Start a new face.  
Do lots of faces.  
what bugs you?

• 5 done? : Is it really gruesome?  
funny? weird? Step  
back. Board on the wall  
Anything bug you? No!

# ARTi play #1: Photomontage

## 5-Point Plan

### **1. You'll need**

- Back board, card, MDF, big photo of a head, other photos, scissors, glue.

### **2. Sources**

- Posters, magazines, calendars, newspaper pics.
- Study the art of Hannah Hoch, Georg Grosz.

### **3. To begin**

- Stick the big photo to the board, cut eyes, mouth, nose, ears, hair, from other pics.
- Stick on top.
- Try moving pieces around before sticking down.

### **4. Stuck?**

- Cut new features to cover the image.
- Start a new face.
- What bugs you?
- Try doing lots of faces.

### **5. Done?**

- Is it really gruesome?
  - Funny?
  - Weird?
  - Step back, put the board on the wall - anything bug you?
- No?

# #2 : animal drawing

## 5. point plan

- 1 you'll need: backboard; card; MDF; paper (cardridge); pencils; pastels (chalks); charcoal; hairspray.
- 2 Sources: finding your animal; a pet; dog, cat, bird. A picture in a book, on internet, an ornament
- 3 to begin: Draw the shape in pencil correcting as you go, not rubbing out. Smudge pastel colour, charcoal in.  
line → smudge
- 4 stuck: Stand back. See fresh. Use a mirror, or phone view. What bugs you? change. Try again!
- 5 done: Step back. Board on the wall. What bugs you? change! Happy? Done!

# ARTi play #2: Animal Drawing

## 5-Point Plan

### **1. You'll need**

- Back board, card, MDF, paper (cartridge), pencils, pastels (chalks), charcoal, hairspray (to fix your picture when finished).

### **2. Sources**

- Finding your animal - a pet, dog, cat, bird, a picture in a book on the internet, an ornament.

### **3. To begin**

- Draw the shape in pencil, correcting as you go, not rubbing out. Smudge the lines.
- Smudge pastel colour, charcoal.

### **4. Stuck?**

- Stand back.
- See fresh by using a mirror or viewing on your phone.
- What bugs you? Change, try again.

### **5. Done?**

- Step back, put the board on the wall.
- What bugs you?

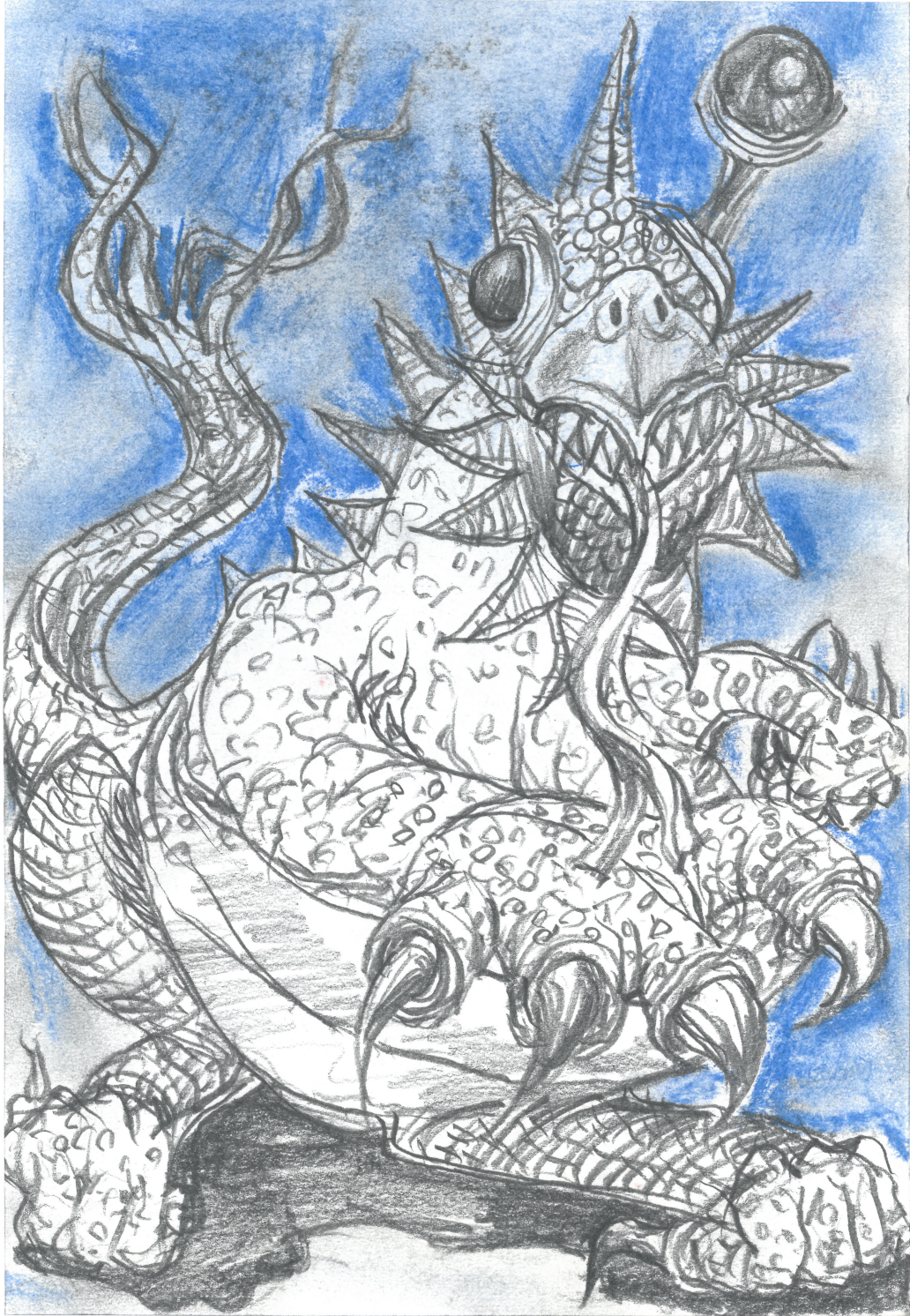

glue: gum, Pritt

backboard, card, MDF  
coloured papers, photos,  
magazine pics; glue  
scissors, coloured pens

### • 2 sources:



pictures of flowers, book,  
internet, mags. look at  
garden, roadside, countryside.

### • 3 to begin:



pick greens for leaves  
sticks to board, overlap.  
cut leaves, cut flowers on top

### • 4 stuck?:

Pattern of flowers, how many?  
colours go together? step  
back. See fresh - in mirror  
on phone! What bugs you?

### • 5 done?:

Step back. Board on wall.  
What bugs you? change?  
Happy? Done
